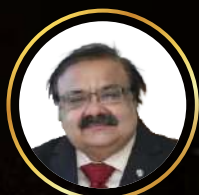

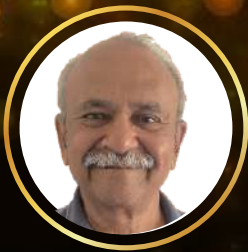

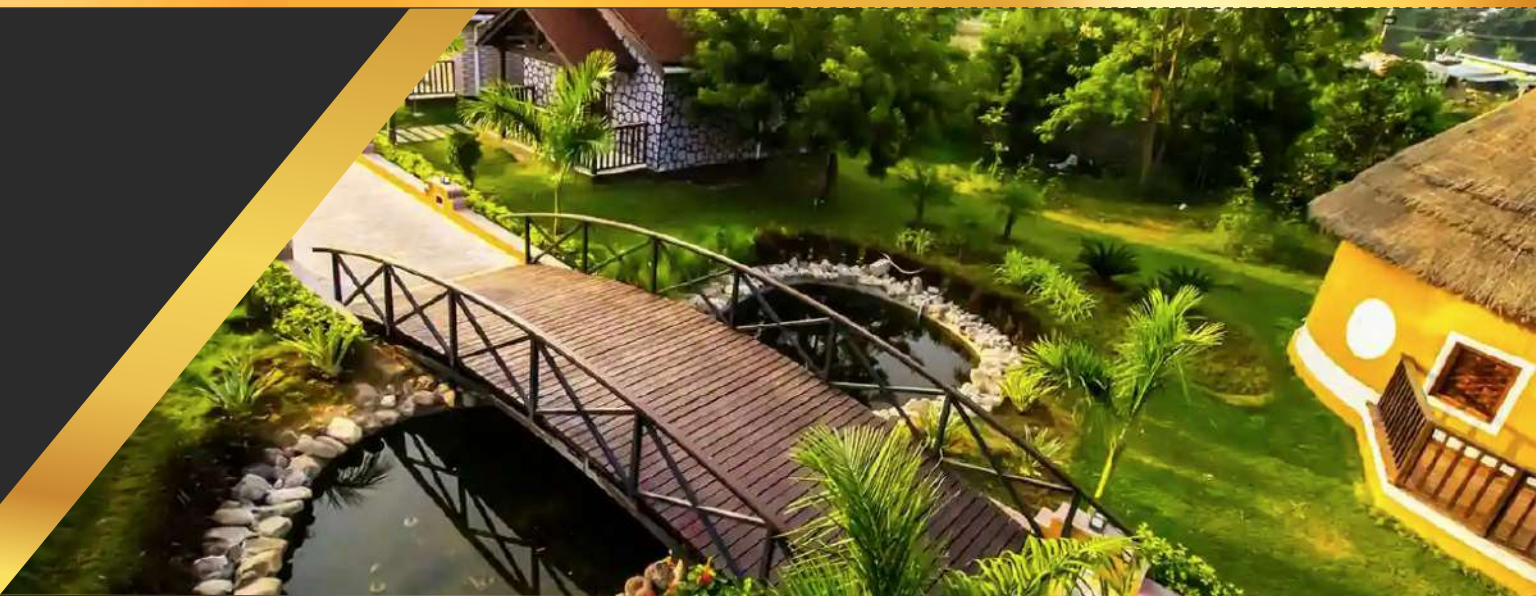

By Train

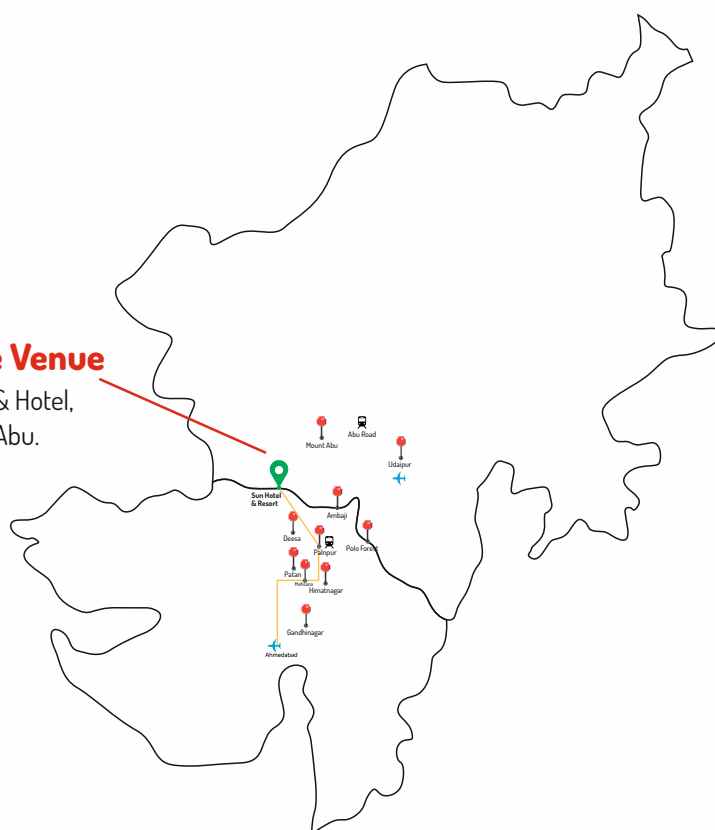

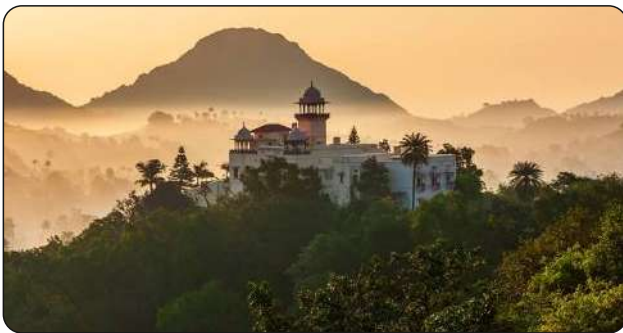
Ambaji Temple

Rani Ki Vav

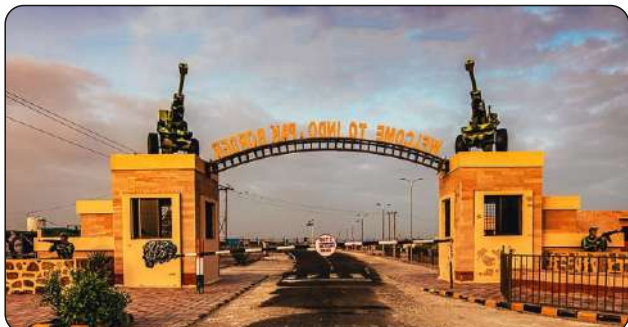
